2020 Committee and Task Force Descriptions

Education: Develops and provides course offerings in management and continuing education; assists our members in the growth and development of their workforce, from support staff all the way to the company CEO. Meetings held the first Tuesday of every month at 8:00 am.

Events: Develops and delivers programming such as the Economic Outlook Breakfast, Golf Outing, Clay Shoot, Meet the Generals, Excellence in Construction Awards Program, Mixers and other events to provide quality business development opportunities for members. Meetings held the first Thursday of every month at 7:30 am.

Government Affairs: Promotes, protects and defends the ABC position on the legal, legislative and regulatory fronts; establishes and maintains strong working relationships with lawmakers; develops and strengthens industry-wide grassroots advocacy efforts to educate, elect, and encourage participation in the political and legislative processes. Meetings held the second Thursday of every month at 7:30 am.

Membership: Works to actively engage ABC members to increase their involvement and improve their overall ABC experience; identifies and pursues new membership growth opportunities. Meetings held the second Tuesday of every month at 7:30 am.

Safety: Promotes safe and healthy work environments for member firms; conducts quarterly Safety Forums for safety and HR professionals and contractors; monitors OSHA regulation developments; promotes and facilitates the STEP (Safety Training and Evaluation Process) program. Meeting held the third Tuesday of every month at 7:30 am.

Workforce Development: Continues to showcase careers in construction and the talents of our member employees; builds bridges between industry and educators on skills needed, plus careers available for K-12 and post-secondary students; utilizes our state-of-the-art training facility as a destination for school in-service days and career days. Meetings held the 2nd Thursday of every month at 7:30 am. *(No meeting to be held in April.)*

Young Professionals: Develops and provides networking activities, leadership and educational opportunities, and community service outreach for those currently in their first 10 years in the industry and who are employees of ABC Keystone member firms. Meetings held the first Thursday of every month at 7:30 am. *(Off-site meetings held in March, June, and September from 3:00 pm - 5:00 pm.)*
